1 Biometric:

Biometric Cashless Catering

The Catering Company Edwards and Blake run Nationwide which is a Biometric System using finger print recognition and is totally cashless.

The School operate an on-line payment system called AGORA for all payments into the School.

2 Queue:

Students should queue outside the PE corridor entrance and should queue in a calm and orderly manner.

3 Priority card (for extra-curricular lunchtime activities):

Students who undertake activities at lunchtime may ask for a lunch priority card from their Form Tutor. This should be completed with the student's name, Form and activity. Students with a priority card should be allowed to enter the Dining Hall first, after duty staff have verified the card details.

4 Packed Lunch:

Packed lunches may be eaten in the Dining Area or Hall. Students should queue with their Year Group to enter the Dining Area. Food and drink may not be eaten in other rooms or buildings.

N.B. Food may be consumed only at break and lunchtime, in the Dining Area, Hall or other outside area.

5 Lunch Break:

Years 7 - 11 Students are not permitted to leave School during the lunch-break unless they have returned the official school form signed by their parents, giving permission for them to lunch at home. They are issued with a lunch pass card that they must carry when off the School site. If, for a special reason, the Headteacher or other senior staff give permission for them to leave School, they must sign out and back in at Student Services. When students are not in the Dining Area they are expected to remain outside, unless attending a club. In the event of inclement weather, students should go to the Dining Area, Hall or Library.
