Higher	Evaluation: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Can discuss how ideas have been presented and comment on how effects have been achieved.• Can give constructive criticism, linking weaknesses with suggestions for improvement.• Can use technical terms when reflecting on the Drama, identifying staging and performance techniques.• Able to work with others constructively and diplomatically, sometimes leading the group.• Able to reflect on own work and contributions with insight, supporting answers with a practical example.
Intermediate	Evaluation: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Can discuss strengths and weaknesses.• Can give constructive criticism.• Can use correct basic drama vocabulary accurately.• Able to work with others with some success.• Able to reflect on own work and contributions with some insight.
Foundation	Evaluation: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Can give simple praise and criticism.• Can suggest ways to improve.• Can use some dramatic vocabulary with confidence. E.g. chorus, mask, direct address, movement, tableaux.• Able to work with most other students in the class.• Able to reflect on own work and contributions with prompts and questions.

NB: direct command = knowledge, 'can'= understanding, 'able to'=skills
