Higher	<p>Pupils/I:</p> <p>Can explain the difference between human, physical and environmental geography and give examples of each.</p> <p>Can map from memory and describe the location of the continents, seas and oceans across the globe.</p> <p>Can map from memory the 4 countries that make up the UK and name and locate their capital city.</p> <p>Can describe the difference between the UK, Britain and the British Isles.</p> <p>Can evaluate different types of map and justify why each is important.</p> <p>Can use longitude and latitude co-ordinates of any interval to locate a specific place on a map and explain why this skill is useful.</p> <p>Can/am able to use a 16 point compass to describe direction.</p> <p>Can/are able to use a scale bar to accurately measure distance on a map at a variety of different scales.</p> <p>Can/are able to use symbols on a map to help describe the key features of an area/location.</p> <p>Can/are able to provide 4 and 6 figure grid references of specific points on a maps of different scales.</p> <p>Can/are able to use contour lines on an OS to state the height of land at different intervals.</p> <p>Can use an OS map to plan a detailed route and justify why this is the best type of map to use.</p>
Intermediate	<p>Pupils/I:</p> <p>can categorise the different topics related to human, physical and environmental geography.</p> <p>Can accurately map the 7 continents of the world and the major seas and oceans.</p> <p>Can identify the 4 countries of the UK along with their capital city. Can locate each country on a map.</p> <p>Can identify different types of map and state why each one might be useful.</p> <p>Can use lines of longitude and latitude to locate a specific place on a map.</p> <p>Can/are able to use an 8 point compass to describe direction.</p> <p>Can/are able to use a scale bar on a map to accurately measure distance on a map.</p> <p>Can/are able to use symbols to show information on a map.</p> <p>Can/are able to use 4 and 6 figure grid references to locate specific points on a map.</p> <p>Can/are able to use contour lines on an OS map to describe the relief of the land.</p>
Foundation	<p>Pupils/I:</p> <p>Can define human, physical and environmental geography.</p> <p>Can identify the 7 continents of the world along with the major seas and oceans.</p> <p>Can name the 4 countries which make up the UK.</p> <p>Can identify different types of maps.</p> <p>Can identify key features of a global map to include the equator, the prime meridian and lines of longitude and latitude.</p> <p>Can/are able to use a 4 point compass to describe direction.</p> <p>Can/are able to use a basic scale to estimate the distance between two places on a map.</p> <p>Can/are able to name basic map symbols.</p> <p>Can/are able to use 4 figure grid references to locate specific points on a map.</p> <p>Can/are able to use contour lines to identify areas of high land and areas of flatter land.</p>
