	Perform, Choreograph, Evaluate
Higher	<p>Perform Can perform the set street dance routine with a clear sense of musicality, rhythm and technique. Movements are refined and executed with projection, emphasis and clear dynamic changes.</p> <p>Choreograph Can choreograph a dance piece that is original and shows an excellent understanding of the 'street' genre. Pupils are also able to integrate spatial patterns successfully with the consideration of transitional movements.</p> <p>Evaluate Can confidently identify and describe the stylistic features within the 'street' genre when watching professional or peers choreography.</p>
Intermediate	<p>Perform Can perform the set street dance routine with accuracy showing an understanding of the correct use of spacing and timing. Movements are executed with projection and clear dynamic changes.</p> <p>Choreograph Can choreograph a dance piece that shows creativity and a good understanding of the 'street' genre. Pupils also demonstrate a clear understanding of different spatial patterns.</p> <p>Evaluate Can identify and describe some of the stylistic features within the 'street' genre when watching professional or peers choreography.</p>
Foundation	<p>Perform Can perform the majority of the set street dance routine with accuracy showing some understanding of correct use of spacing and timing. Style is considered but is not consistent throughout.</p> <p>Choreograph Can choreograph a dance piece that shows some creativity and understanding of the 'street' genre. Pupils also demonstrate a simple understanding of different spatial patterns.</p> <p>Evaluate Can identify the simple stylistic features within the 'street' genre when watching professional or peers choreography.</p>

NB: 'can' = understanding, 'able to' = skills
