Dear Parent/Carer

Year 11 GCSE Art visit to The Pitt Rivers Museum, Oxford 4th October 2018

As part of the GCSE course it is vital to see works of art first hand and particularly at this time of the year to help prepare for the trial Art exam. Your son/daughter has already expressed an interest in attending this visit, so I have booked places accordingly.

We will be travelling to Oxford by coach departing from The Hemel Hempstead School at 9am (students are to register as normal then meet the Art staff by the pillars by 8.50am) to arrive at the Pitt Rivers Museum at approximately 10.30am. Due to the tight schedule students will need to bring a packed lunch with them, as they will not be able to purchase food at either the gallery or in the surrounding area. We expect to return to school at 3.30pm.

I am sure that it will be a most enjoyable and beneficial experience. I must however ask for a contribution of £12 to cover the cost of the visit. We wish to make it clear that no student will be denied participation in the visit if there is difficulty in meeting the cost, but if sufficient money is not raised by voluntary contributions the trip will not take place. Please access the online system to pay and give your consent. In exceptional circumstances payment may be made over the phone by card.

If a student will miss a music lesson due to a school trip/event it is vital that they inform their instrumental music teacher at least one week in advance in order to avoid the lesson being forfeited.

Please note that all students are expected to wear full school uniform and for the purpose of the trip they may also bring mobile phones in case of a delayed return. However, these must be switched off and are taken at their own risk.
