## **Year 11 Careers Interviews**

Careers advice is an important part of the information and guidance that students receive throughout their school life and the guidance programme that we offer is wide, varied and designed to meet the specific needs of students at different stages. Students are supported in developing the skills to understand themselves, investigate opportunities and plan for transition so they are able to make well informed and realistic decisions about what they want to do with their life.

Year 11 is a critical stage where decisions about the future start to be made and therefore we would like to give all students the opportunity to discuss the various options available after Year 11 as well as any career ideas with either myself or one of our Youth Connexions Personal Advisors who are Hilary Stephens and Emma Readman. They will be told about all the options open to them such as 6<sup>th</sup> form, college and apprenticeships and also to receive information about university courses if this is something they might be interested in doing in the future.
