Block E Home Study

In order to help facilitate students' study and revision this year, after October half term we are planning to offer Home Study to Year 13 students during Block E (Monday Periods 1 and 2 and Wednesday Periods 3-5). These are the busiest times for study facilities for Sixth form students.

In order to be granted this privilege students must have done one of the following:

1. Completed and sent their UCAS application.
2. Had a careers meeting with Mrs Bond.
3. Shown evidence to their Form Tutor or myself that next steps (beyond Sixth form) have been investigated and ongoing (this can include: registered on apprenticeships website; applied for jobs).

I do understand that some students have not made a decision about where their future lies and that is totally understandable, but we do expect students to be actively investigating the options available to them.

Once a student has been granted Block E Home Study they will be notified by their Form Tutor. Students must then meet the school safety requirement of signing in and out in the Sixth form study room. If a student fails to do this, absence messages will be sent home.

Block E Home Study is an option; students are more than welcome to continue to study in school at these times. All other study periods must still be taken in school; this will be reviewed once the trial exams are complete in January.
