This letter is to give you information concerning the practice expedition at Easter 2019, from Thursday 4th April to Wednesday 10th April.

Training Day

This will take place at school on Sunday 3rd February. All participants will be expected to attend. The students will plan their routes and take part in appropriate training activities.
