Year 7 Trip to St. Albans Cathedral and Neasden Mandir
ACF: Monday 3rd June 2019
LNP: Tuesday 4th June 2019

As part of the Religious Art and Pilgrimage element of the Key Stage 3 Religious Education curriculum, we have created an opportunity for students to see contrasting places of worship, the art that is utilised during worship and to partake in some arranged activities at the sites.

The visits will take place on Monday 3rd June for students in 7ACF and Tuesday 4th June for students in 7LNP. We will be leaving the school site at approximately 9am and returning in time for the end of the school day. Students will be required to bring a packed lunch. (Something that makes very little mess as they have to eat on the coach between the two sites). Students will not be required to wear uniform. However, as we are visiting places of worship ALL students must wear trousers and have their arms and shoulders covered. If they are not dressed appropriately, they will not be allowed on the coach. Students must be mindful that St Albans Cathedral and Neasden Mandir are also active places of worship so they should behave appropriately.

The cost of the trip is £19.70 which covers the cost of the coach, activities and small donations to the organisations. We wish to make it clear that no student will be denied participation in the visit because of genuine difficulty in meeting the cost. However if sufficient money is not raised by voluntary contributions, the trip will not take place. Payment is not expected from those students who are currently or who have previously been in receipt of free school meals. Please access Sims.pay to pay and give your consent. In exceptional circumstances payment may be made over the phone by card.

If a student will miss a Music lesson due to a school trip/event it is vital that they inform their instrumental Music teacher at least two weeks before in order to avoid the lesson being forfeited.
