Aspire Higher Project

We are very pleased to announce that we are going to be working with the Aspire Higher Project on a wide range of activities over the coming year.

Aspire Higher is a collaborative network between the University of Hertfordshire and the University of Bedfordshire. They offer students exciting opportunities to increase their knowledge of options after school, increase their confidence and inspire them to aim high.

It is part of the National Collaborative Outreach Programme (NCOP) which is funded by the Office for Students. They work with pupils who live in certain postcodes within the Government's target wards. For Aspire Higher these include certain postcodes within our area including Grove Hill and Highfield.

Aspire Higher delivers information and guidance about university and apprenticeships in school. They also fund out of school activities including residential trips and visit days and all activities are free to the school and pupils.

In April and May, representatives from Aspire Higher will be running workshops in school for students in Years 9 and 10. These will take place during school time and will include topics such as going to university and study skills. The first session will take place on 25th April in Period 1.
